Work to install a new item of play equipment at Ringstead Playing Field are completed

A new and exciting item of play equipment has been installed at Ringstead Playing Field.

Following the removal of the old roundabout, local resident Jay Mond-Wedd and his family at Courtyard Farm Trust initiated and have financially supported the project. Looking for something more challenging for older children and working with the Parish Council, it was decided to install Wicksteed Leisure 'Pick Up Sticks' climber.

Based on the classic game of the same name they are great fun, their non-uniform style means a different adventure every time! The Pick Up Sticks represents a great playground challenge for all older children.
